Workshops

Helping participants during the event

Judging

Judges evaluate from **5 to 15 advanced projects**. The projects are judged based on the following criteria: design, technicality and creativity. Judging will take place Saturday January 14, 2023 between **7-8 PM**. Project presentations is in a "science fair" format: judges will move from table to table to evaluate every team's program.

Online

Judges evaluate from **5 to 15 advanced projects**. The projects are judged based on the following criteria: design, technicality and creativity. Judging will take place Saturday between **7-8 PM on Devpost**.
